PARK PAVILION RULES & REGULATIONS

Pavilion rental time is 10:00 a.m. – dusk

Reservation Fees:

Weekdays - \$75.00 (resident*)
 \$100.00 (non-resident)
Weekends & Holidays - \$100.00 (resident*)
 \$150.00 (non-resident)

*Proof of residency required for resident rate.

NOTE: Photo ID is required for all rentals, and payment must be made in full when making reservation.

Pavilions:

Monocacy Park

Shelter #1 – large one closest to street; seats 50 – (8 tables)
Shelter #2 – near the falls; seats 30 – (5 tables)

South Mountain

Shelter #1 – lower pavilion; 80 seats (wooded area) – (8 tables)
Shelter #2 – upper pavilion; 50 – 60 seats, large field area – (6 tables)

Pavilion Rules:

- Payment must be made in full when making reservations. **There will be no refunds issued unless the reservation is cancelled by the Recreation Bureau due to extenuating circumstances.**
Reservations WILL NOT be cancelled due to rain events.
- Alcoholic beverage use is limited to brewed beverages and wine with an alcohol content of no more than 12%. Permitted containers are metallic, with maximum content of 16 ounces, and wine boxes. Glass bottles & kegs are prohibited.
- The parking of vehicles is prohibited in areas other than the designated parking lots.
- Pavilions must be left in good condition. Garbage must be bagged and put in or near receptacles.
- Confetti, smoke, dust, glitter or anything that will pollute the park and surrounding areas is not allowed.
- No amplified music, DJ's or bands. Noise must be kept at a legal volume as stated in [City Parks Article # 941](#).
- No additional grills can be brought to the park.
- No inflatable structures (bounce houses, etc.)
- Permit will be issued at time of payment and must be kept on site during the rental period.
- No fireworks, fire related items or weapons of any kind.
- No decorations or other materials should be nailed, tacked, stapled or screwed to any pavilion or its contents.
- All park rules as stated in [City Parks Article #941](#) must be followed.

NOTE: Failure to comply with the above expectations could result in additional charges and/or denial of future rentals.
